PART I. REGISTRATION

Registration started at 12 noon until 1PM which was facilitated by the Area Coordinators.

PART II. OPENING PROGRAM

A. Opening Program

The opening activities followed at 1:35 PM

- Call to Order
- BOD Chairperson Daniel N. Vescatcho, Jr. called the meeting to order at 1:35 PM
- Reading of Proof of Due Notice
- Determination of Quorum

A quorum was declared with the attendance of 2,061 or 49% of the total 4,295 Members Entitled to Vote (METV). At least 25% of the total number of METV constitutes a quorum in the General Assembly as stipulated in the Coop By-Laws.

PART III. BUSINESS MEETING

B. Reading and Approval of Previous Minutes

The highlights of the minutes of the 51st Annual General Assembly held last March 22, 2015 was read.

Mrs. Corazon Jarandillo suggested that the minutes of the previous 51st Annual General Assembly shall be included in the program.

C. Presentation and Approval of Reports

1. Report of the Board

BOD Chairperson Daniel N. Vescatcho Jr. read the fifteen (15) Resolutions passed by the Board in 2015.

For the information of the general membership, Ms. Marly Pamiyaron commented that based on RA. 9520, Audit and Inventory Committee is now called Audit Committee.

The Audit Committee Report was approved upon motion made by Ms. Magdalena Otico and seconded by Ms. Leonida Fontanillas.

4. Election Committee

Report was presented by Ms. Victoria Barcelona, ELECOM Chairperson.

The Election Committee Report was approved upon motion made by Ms. Corazon Jarandillo and seconded by Mr. Napoleon Delos Santos.

5. Mediation and Conciliation Committee

Report was presented by Judge Francisco Guzman, MedCon Chairperson.

Mr. Alex Dollolaso inquired on the comparative data of delinquent members for 2014 compared to 2015, which of the two had an increase on PAR. He further stressed that hopefully for 2016 the PAR will decrease significantly.

GM Rodelyn Berto presented to the general membership that the trending PAR is slightly the same compared to the last year. The Mediation and Conciliation Committee is created to help monitor the delinquency.

The Mediation and Conciliation Committee Report was approved upon motion made by Mr. Alex Dollolaso and seconded by Ms. Corazon Jarandillo.

6. Ethics Committee

Report was presented by BOD Fe R. Bravo, committee chairperson

The Ethics Committee Report was approved upon motion made by Ms. Belinda Ferancullo and seconded by Mr. Erwin Londres.

7. Social Development and Services Committee

Report was presented by BOD Eliseo C. Canalin, Chairperson Social Services and Development Committee

Mr. Rodolfo Opiña commented if there are sustainability measures on the mangrove reforestation program of the cooperative.

8. Anti- Delinquency Committee

Auditors' Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements

My objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatements, whether due to fraud or error and to issue an auditor's report that includes my opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with PSA will always detect material misstatement when it exists. Misstatement can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of the users taken on the basis of these consolidated financial statements.

As part of an audit in accordance with PSA, I exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. I also:

- Identify and assesses the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedure responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by the management.
- Conclude on the appropriateness of management's use of the going concern basis of accounting and based on the audit evidence obtained, whether a material uncertainty exists related to events or conditions that may cast significant doubt on the entity's ability to continue as a going concern. If I conclude that a material uncertainty exists, I am required to draw attention in my auditor's report to the related disclosures in the financial statements or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify my opinion.

My conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of my auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the entity to cease to continue as a going concern.

- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the financial statements, including the disclosures, and whether the financial statements represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.

I communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that I can identify during the audit.

I also provide those charged with governance with a statement that I have complied with relevant ethical requirements regarding independence, and to communicate with them all relationships and other matters that may reasonably be thought to bear on my independence, and where applicable, related safeguards.

From the matters communicated with those charged with governance, I determine those matters that were of most significance in the audit of the financial statements of the current period and are therefore the key audit matters. I describe these matters in my auditor's report unless law or regulation precludes public disclosure about the matter or when, in extremely rare circumstances, I determine that a matter should not be communicated in my report because the adverse consequences of doing so would reasonably be expected to outweigh the public interest benefits of such communication.
